- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter F, Chapter 502, Transportation Code,
- 6 is amended by adding Section 502.2935 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 502.2935. STATE TREE LICENSE PLATES. (a) The
- 8 department shall issue specially designed State Tree license plates
- 9 for passenger cars and light trucks.
- 10 (b) The license plates must include the words "Stand tall
- 11 <u>for Texas trees," depict the state tree,</u> and be of a color, quality,
- and design approved by the Texas Urban Forestry Council.
- 13 (c) The department shall issue license plates under this
- 14 section to a person who:
- 15 (1) applies to the county assessor-collector of the
- 16 county in which the person resides on a form provided by the
- 17 department; and
- 18 (2) pays an annual fee of \$30, in addition to the fee
- 19 prescribed by Section 502.161 or Section 502.162, and, if
- 20 personalized prestige license plates are issued, in addition to the
- 21 fee prescribed by Section 502.251.
- 22 (d) The department shall deposit \$20 of each fee collected
- 23 under this section to the credit of the Texas Urban Forestry Council
- 24 account in the state treasury. Money in the account may be used

- only by the Texas Forest Service in making grants to benefit the
- 2 Texas Urban Forestry Council.
- 3 (e) The remainder of each fee collected under this section,
- 4 after deposit as provided by Subsection (d), shall be deposited to
- 5 the credit of the state highway fund and may be used only to defray
- 6 the cost of administering this section.
- 7 (f) If the owner of a vehicle registered under this section
- 8 <u>disposes of the vehicle during the registration year, the owner</u>
- 9 shall return the special license plates to the department.
- 10 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
