8	Education is an agency of this state and consists of nine members
9	appointed by the governor with the advice and consent of the senate

11	(1) one member who is a sheriff;
12	(2) one member who is a constable;
13	(3) one member who is a chief [three members who are
14	sheriffs, constables, or chiefs] of police;
15	(4) $[(2)$ ] three members who:
16	(A) are licensed under this chapter, two of whom
17	are peace officers who, at the time of appointment, hold
18	nonsupervisory positions with a law enforcement agency; and

(5) [(3)] three members who represent the public.

SECTION 2. Section 1701.054(a), Occupations Code, is

(a) Appointed commission members serve staggered six-year

five years preceding the date of appointment; and

- 2 (1) the term of the member [one of the members]

- 12 member serving on the commission immediately before the effective
- 13 date of this Act to continue to carry out the commission's functions
- 14 for the remainder of the member's term. The changes in law apply
- only to a member appointed on or after the effective date of this
- 16 Act. This Act does not prohibit a person who is a member of the
- 17 commission on the effective date of this Act from being reappointed
- 18 to the commission if the person has the qualifications required for
- a member under Section 1701.051(a), Occupations Code, as amended by
- 20 this Act.
- 21 (b) As soon as possible on or after the effective date of
- 22 this Act, as the terms of members of the Commission on Law
- 23 Enforcement Officer Standards and Education expire or as vacancies
- occur, the governor shall appoint members to the commission so that
- 25 the commission is composed in accordance with Section 1701.051(a),
- Occupations Code, as amended by this Act.
- 27 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

- 1 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 2 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 3 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 4 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
