(4) 8 SECTION 2. (a) This Act takes effect September 1, 2003. 9 The change in law made by this Act applies only to an (b) 10 offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. 11 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is covered 12 by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and the former 13 law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of this 14 subsection, an offense was committed before the effective date of 15 16 this Act if any element of the offense was committed before that 17 date.
