## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the prosecution of a capital murder involving the death
- 3 of a peace officer.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 2, Code of Criminal Procedure, is
- 6 amended by adding Article 2.011 to read as follows:
- 7 Art. 2.011. DUTY IN CERTAIN CAPITAL CASES. If a defendant
- 8 is charged with an offense under Section 19.03(a)(1), Penal Code,
- 9 and the victim of the alleged offense is a peace officer, the
- 10 attorney representing the state shall seek the imposition of the
- 11 death penalty on conviction of the defendant.
- 12 SECTION 2. (a) The change in law made by this Act applies
- only to the prosecution of an offense committed on or after the
- 14 effective date of this Act. For purposes of this section, an
- 15 offense is committed before the effective date of this Act if any
- 16 element of the offense occurs before the effective date.
- 17 (b) The prosecution of an offense committed before the
- 18 effective date of this Act is covered by the law in effect when the
- 19 offense was committed, and the former law is continued in effect for
- that purpose.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
