S.B. No. 321

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the compensation of an election judge or clerk in a
3 general election.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 32.091(a), Election Code, is amended to
6 read as follows:

7 (a) An election judge or clerk is entitled to compensation
8 for services rendered at a precinct polling place at an hourly rate
9 not to exceed the amount fixed by the appropriate authority, which
10 amount must be at least the federal minimum hourly wage. A judge or
11 clerk may be compensated at that rate for services rendered under
12 Section 62.014(c). For a general election, the rate must be at
13 least \$8 per hour.

14 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003, and
15 applies only to compensation for an election judge or clerk for
16 services rendered on or after that date.
