- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 32.091(a), Election Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (a) An election judge or clerk is entitled to compensation
- 8 for services rendered at a precinct polling place at an hourly rate
- 9 not to exceed the amount fixed by the appropriate authority, which
- 10 amount must be at least the federal minimum hourly wage. A judge or
- 11 clerk may be compensated at that rate for services rendered under
- 12 Section 62.014(c). For a general election, the rate must be at
- 13 <u>least \$8 per hour.</u>
- 14 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003, and
- 15 applies only to compensation for an election judge or clerk for
- 16 services rendered on or after that date.
