1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to statistical information concerning certain judicial
1-9 proceedings to bypass parental notice of a minor's abortion.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Chapter 33, Family Code, is amended by adding
1-12 Section 33.012 to read as follows:

1-13 Sec. 33.012. STATISTICAL INFORMATION. (a) The supreme
1-14 court shall adopt rules governing the collection of statistical
1-15 information relating to:

1-16 (1) the number of applications filed, granted, and
1-17 denied under Section 33.003 and the number of applications deemed
1-18 to be granted under Section 33.003(h); and

1-19 (2) the number of appeals made, granted, and denied
1-20 under Section 33.004 and the number of appeals deemed to be granted
1-21 under Section 33.004(b).

1-22 (b) The information collected under this section shall be
1-23 made available to the public in aggregate form on a regional basis,
1-24 as determined by the court.

1-25 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-26 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-27 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-28 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-29 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
