1 AN ACT 2 relating to single-member districts for the board of the Barton 3 Springs-Edwards Aquifer Conservation District. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 SECTION 1. Section 7, Chapter 429, Acts of the 70th 6 Legislature, Regular Session, 1987, is amended by adding 7 Subsections (d) through (h) to read as follows: 8 (d) The district is divided into five numbered 9 single-member districts for electing directors. The board may 10 revise the single-member districts as necessary or appropriate. 11 (e) The board shall revise the single-member districts as 12 soon as practicable after the publication of each federal decenniation
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13 <u>census as the board considers appropriate to reflect population</u>
14 changes.
15 (f) When the board revises the single-member districts
16 <u>under Subsection (e) of this section</u> , the board shall place two of
17 the districts entirely within the boundaries of the City of Austin
18 as they exist at that time. Changes in the boundaries of the City of
19 Austin between revisions of the single-member districts under
20 <u>Subsection (e) of this section do not affect the boundaries of the</u>
21 <u>single-member districts.</u>
22 (g) Notwithstanding Subsection (f) of this section, the two
23 single-member districts within the boundaries of the City of Austin
24 may include unincorporated areas and other municipalities that are

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1	surrounded wholly or partly by the boundaries of the City of Austin
2	if the areas or municipalities are noncontiguous to the territory
3	of any other single-member district.
4	(h) When the boundaries of the single-member districts are
5	changed, a director in office on the effective date of the change,
6	or elected or appointed before the effective date of the change to a
7	term of office beginning on or after the effective date of the
8	change, is entitled to serve the term or the remainder of the term
9	in the single-member district to which elected or appointed even
10	though the change in boundaries places the person's residence
11	outside the single-member district for which the person was elected
12	or appointed.

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13 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
