13	(b) An order of the commission under Section 203.031(a)(2)
14	or (4) does not supersede a conflicting rule or ordinance of a
15	municipality, including a home-rule municipality, unless the
16	United States Department of Transportation Federal Highway
17	Administration notifies the department that enforcement of the
18	municipal rule or ordinance would impair the ability of the state or
19	the department to receive funds for highway construction or
20	maintenance from the federal government.
21	(c) Subsection (b) does not apply when the department owns
22	the access rights.
23	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
24	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
