1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to the dissolution of the Huffsmith Road Public Utility
1-9 District.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. DISSOLUTION. (a) The Huffsmith Road Public
1-12 Utility District is dissolved.

1-13 (b) Chapter 676, Acts of the 62nd Legislature, Regular
1-14 Session, 1971, is repealed.

1-15 SECTION 2. FINDINGS RELATED TO DISSOLUTION. The
1-16 legislature finds that the Huffsmith Road Public Utility District:

1-17 (1) has no outstanding assets, obligations, or
1-18 indebtedness;

1-19 (2) has been and remains inactive; and

1-20 (3) serves no public purpose.

1-21 SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect
1-22 immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members
1-23 elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas
1-24 Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for
1-25 immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
