## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:							
5	SECTION 1. Subsection (d), Section 60.404, Water Code, is							
6	amended to read as follows:							
7	(d) The specifications must:							
8	(1) describe in detail the item to be acquired;							
9	(2) require that bids be sealed; [and]							
10	(3) require the attachment to the bid of a certified							
11	check, cashier's check, or bidders bond <u>; and</u>							
12	(4) indicate whether a small business development							
13	program adopted by the port commission of the port authority or							
14	district applies to the purchase and, if so, where a copy of the							
15	program requirements may be obtained.							
16	SECTION 2. Section 60.4125, Water Code, is amended by							
17	adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:							
18	(d) If a purchase or contract made under Subsection (a) is							
19	subject to a small business development program adopted by the port							
20	commission of the port authority or district, the purchase							
21	solicitation must indicate that fact and must also indicate where a							
22	copy of the program requirements may be obtained.							
23	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives							
24	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
