- Δ BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- SECTION 1. The section heading of Section 791.006, 5
- Government Code, is amended to read as follows: 6
- 7 Sec. 791.006. LIABILITY IN ABSENCE OF [FIRE PROTECTION]
- CONTRACT FOR [OR] PROVISION OF FIRE, EMERGENCY, OR LAW ENFORCEMENT 8
- 9 SERVICES.

- SECTION 2. Section 791.006, Government Code, is amended by 10
- amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsections (d) and (e) to read 11
- 12 as follows:
- 13 In the absence of a contract, if a governmental unit
- 14 furnishes fire or emergency services to another governmental unit,
- 15 the governmental unit that requests and obtains the services [##
- governmental units contract under this chapter to furnish or obtain 16
- the services of a fire department, the governmental unit that would 17
- have been responsible for furnishing the services in the absence of 18
- 19 the contract] is responsible for any civil liability that arises
- from the furnishing of those services. 20
- (d) Nothing in this section affects the employer-employee 21
- 22 relationship or the terms or conditions of employment between a
- governmental unit and its employees, such as the payment of wages or 23
- 24 provision of benefits.

- 1 (e) For the purposes of this section, "governmental unit"
  2 does not include a school district.
- 3 SECTION 3. (a) The change in law made by this Act to
- 4 Section 791.006, Government Code, does not affect any civil
- 5 liability for services furnished under an interlocal cooperation
- 6 contract to furnish or obtain the services of a fire department
- 7 entered into before the effective date of this Act.
- 8 (b) The former law is continued in effect for the purpose of
- 9 determining liability, if any, for services furnished under an
- 10 interlocal cooperation contract to furnish or obtain the services
- of a fire department entered into before the effective date of this
- 12 Act.
- 13 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 14 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 15 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 16 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 17 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
