1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to requiring the comptroller of public accounts to assess
1-9 the feasibility of a central database containing information on
1-10 special districts.

1-11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-12 SECTION 1. (a) The comptroller of public accounts shall
1-13 study the feasibility of maintaining a central database available
1-14 to the public that contains tax rates, functions, and other
1-15 pertinent information for each special district in this state.

1-16 (b) Not later than November 15, 2004, the comptroller of
1-17 public accounts shall file a report containing the results of the
1-18 study required by Subsection (a) of this section with the governor,
1-19 the lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the house of
1-20 representatives.

1-21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.

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
