7	SYSTEM. (a) The state emergency services and trauma care system
8	provides emergency services and trauma care to residents of this
9	state through county and regional providers of emergency services
10	and trauma care. The state system consists of designated emergency
11	services and trauma care entities, including:
12	(1) each trauma service area regional advisory
13	council; and
14	(2) a council of government that includes a county
15	with a population of at least 3.3 million and that has established a
16	trauma and emergency services policy council.
17	(b) Money, including money available under federal law, may

- (c) An entity that is a part of the state's emergency 20
