- 8 (a) An insurer or other entity described by Section 1(a) of this
- 9 article that issues a Medicare supplement policy in this state must
- 10 also offer the group or individual policyholder:
- 11 (1) an outpatient prescription drug benefit plan
- 12 authorized under 42 U.S.C. Section 1395ss;
- 13 (2) a new or innovative outpatient prescription drug
- 14 benefit plan filed with and approved by the commissioner under
- 15 Section 2(b) of this article; or
- 16 (3) a basic or extended outpatient prescription drug
- benefit plan prescribed by the commissioner.
- 18 <u>(b) The group or individual policyholder may reject</u>
- 19 coverage required to be offered under this section.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003, and
- 21 applies only to a Medicare supplement policy that is delivered,
- 22 issued for delivery, or renewed on or after January 1, 2004. A
- 23 Medicare supplement policy that is delivered, issued for delivery,
- or renewed before January 1, 2004, is governed by the law as it
