5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Subsections (a) and (d), Section 534.038, Health
7	and Safety Code, are amended to read as follows:
8	(a) The commissioner may appoint a manager or management
9	team to manage and operate a community center if the commissioner
10	finds that[+
11	[(1)] the center or an officer or employee of the
12	center:
13	(1) [(A)] intentionally, recklessly, or negligently
14	failed to discharge the center's duties under a contract with the
15	department;
16	(2) [(B)] misused state or federal money;
17	(3) $[(C)]$ engaged in a fraudulent act, transaction,
18	practice, or course of business;
19	(4) [(D)] endangers or may endanger the life, health,
20	or safety of a person served by the center;
21	<u>(5)</u> [(E)] failed to keep fiscal records or maintain
22	proper control over center assets as prescribed by Chapter 783,
23	Government Code;
24	<u>(6)</u> [(F)] failed to respond to a deficiency in a

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1 review or audit;

2 <u>(7)</u> [(G)] substantially failed to operate within the 3 functions and purposes defined in the center's plan; or

4 (8) [(H)] otherwise substantially failed to comply
5 with this subchapter or department rules[+ and

6 [(2) contract sanctions and intervention with the 7 local board of trustees failed to bring the center into compliance 8 with the center's plan or contract].

9 (d) The center may appeal the commissioner's decision to 10 appoint a manager or management team as prescribed by board rule. 11 The filing of a notice of appeal stays the appointment unless the 12 commissioner based the appointment on a finding under Subsection 13 (a)(2) or (4) [(a)(1)(D)].

SECTION 2. Subsections (b) and (c), Section 534.040, Health and Safety Code, are amended to read as follows:

16 (b) The authority of the manager or management team 17 continues until[+

18 [(1)] the commissioner determines that the relevant 19 factors listed under Section <u>534.038(a)</u> [534.038(a)(1)] no longer 20 <u>apply</u> [exist; or

21 [(2) the department cancels its contract with the 22 center].

Following а determination under Subsection 23 (c) (b) [(b)(1)], the commissioner shall terminate the authority of the 24 25 manager or management team and restore authority to manage and operate the center to the center's authorized officers 26 and 27 employees.

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1 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 2 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 3 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 4 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 5 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
