- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 30.05, Penal Code, is amended by adding
- 6 Subsection (f) to read as follows:
- 7 <u>(f) It is an exception to the application of this section</u>
- 8 that:
- 9 (1) the property or land on which the person entered
- 10 was owned or leased by a governmental entity and was not property or
- 11 land described by Section 46.03 or 46.035;
- 12 (2) the basis on which entry on the property or land
- was forbidden is that entry with a handgun was forbidden; and
- 14 (3) the person was carrying a concealed handgun and a
- 15 license issued under Subchapter H, Chapter 411, Government Code, to
- 16 carry a concealed handgun of the same category the person was
- 17 carrying.
- SECTION 2. Section 30.06, Penal Code, is amended by adding
- 19 Subsection (e) to read as follows:
- 20 (e) It is an exception to the application of this section
- 21 that the property on which the license holder carries a handgun is
- 22 owned or leased by a governmental entity and is not property
- 23 described by Section 46.03 or 46.035.
- SECTION 3. (a) This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.

(b) The change in law made by this Act applies only to an offense committed on or after September 1, 2003. An offense committed before September 1, 2003, is covered by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of this subsection, an offense was committed before September 1, 2003, if any element of the offense was committed before that date.
