A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the provision of certain higher education information
3	to the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board and to the public.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 51, Education Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 51.968 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 51.968. DISSEMINATION OF INFORMATION REGARDING
8	STUDENT ENROLLMENT AND INSTITUTIONAL EFFECTIVENESS. (a) In this
9	section, "institution of higher education" has the meaning assigned
10	by Section 61.003.
11	(b) Each institution of higher education shall provide to
12	the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board and post on the
13	institution's Internet website in a manner accessible to the public
14	the following information:
15	(1) a description of any departments, schools, or
16	certificate or degree programs of the institution that have a
17	statewide or national reputation for excellence;
18	(2) rates of tuition and fees for resident and
19	nonresident students;
20	(3) student retention and graduation rates; and
21	(4) statistics regarding job placement rates for
22	students awarded certificates or degrees by the institution.
23	(c) The coordinating board by rule shall establish
24	standards and adopt formats for the information provided and posted

- 2 (d) As soon as practicable after a material change in the
- 3 information required under Subsection (b), the institution of
- 4 higher education shall provide to the coordinating board and post
- 5 on the website the updated information.
- 6 SECTION 2. (a) Section 1 of this Act applies beginning
- 7 with the 2004 spring semester.
- 8 (b) The Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board shall
- 9 adopt rules regarding standards and formats for the information
- 10 described by Subsection (b), Section 51.968, Education Code, as
- 11 added by this Act, as soon as practicable after this Act takes
- 12 effect.
- 13 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 14 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 15 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 16 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 17 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
