- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 11.14(a), Tax Code, is amended to read as
- 6 follow:
- 7 (a) A [Except as otherwise provided by this subsection, a]
- 8 person is entitled to an exemption from taxation of all tangible
- 9 personal property, other than manufactured homes, that the person
- 10 owns and that is not held or used for production of income. [This
- 11 subsection does not exempt from taxation a travel trailer, as
- 12 defined by Section 11.142, that a person owns.
- SECTION 2. Section 11.142, Tax Code, is repealed.
- 14 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect January 1, 2004, and
- applies only to taxes imposed for a tax year beginning on or after
- January 1, 2002, but only if the constitutional amendment proposed
- 17 by the 78th Legislature, Regular Session, 2003, authorizing the
- 18 legislature to exempt from ad valorem taxation certain travel
- 19 trailers not held or used for the production of income is approved
- 20 by the voters. If that amendment is not approved by the voters,
- 21 this Act has no effect.
