3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 62.102, Government Code, is amended to
5	read as follows:
6	Sec. 62.102. GENERAL QUALIFICATIONS FOR JURY SERVICE. A
7	person is disqualified to serve as a petit juror unless the person

- 9 (1) is at least 18 years of age;
- 10 (2) is a citizen of this state and of the county in
  11 which the person [he] is to serve as a juror;
- 12 (3) is qualified under the constitution and laws to
  13 vote in the county in which the person [he] is to serve as a juror;
- 14 (4) is of sound mind and good moral character;
- 15 (5) is able to read and write;
- 16 (6) has not served as a petit juror for six days during
  17 the preceding three months in the county court or during the
- 18 preceding six months in the district court;
- 19 (7) has not been convicted of <u>misdemeanor or felony</u>
  20 <u>theft or any other</u> [a] felony; and
- 21 (8) is not under indictment or other legal accusation 22 of misdemeanor or felony theft or any other felony.
- SECTION 2. Section 62.102, Government Code, as amended by this Act, applies only to qualifications for jury service for a

- 1 person required to appear for jury service by a summons made on or
- 2 after September 1, 2003. The qualifications of a person required to
- 3 appear for jury service before September 1, 2003, are covered by the
- 4 law in effect on the date the summons is made, and the former law is
- 5 continued in effect for that purpose.
- 6 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
