- relating to the composition of the 83rd Judicial District and to the election of the district attorney for that district.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 24.185, Government Code, is amended to 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 24.185. 83RD JUDICIAL DISTRICT (PECOS, TERRELL,
- 8 $[\frac{\text{UPTON}_{7}}{\text{I}}]$ AND VAL VERDE COUNTIES). (a) The 83rd Judicial District
- 9 is composed of Pecos, Terrell, [Upton,] and Val Verde counties.
- 10 (b) The 83rd and 112th district courts have concurrent
 11 jurisdiction in Pecos County [and Upton counties].
- 12 (c) The 83rd and 63rd district courts have concurrent 13 jurisdiction in Terrell and Val Verde counties.
- 14 (d) The terms of the 83rd District Court begin[+
- 15 $\left[\frac{(1)}{(1)}\right]$ on the second Monday in January and July $\left[\frac{1}{(1)}\right]$
- 16 [(2) in Upton County on the 12th Monday after the first
- 17 Mondays in January and July].
- (e) In each of the counties of Pecos, Terrell, [Upton,] and
- 19 Val Verde, a petition or other pleading filed in the district courts
- 20 is sufficient if addressed "To The District Court of Pecos County,
- 21 Texas,", "To The District Court of Terrell County, Texas,", ["To
- 22 The District Court of Upton County, Texas,", or "To The District
- 23 Court of Val Verde County, Texas," respectively, without giving the
- 24 number of the district court in the address.

- 1 SECTION 2. Section 43.141(a), Government Code, is amended
- 2 to read as follows:
- 3 (a) The voters of Brewster, Jeff Davis, Pecos, and Presidio
- 4 [, and Upton] counties elect a district attorney for the 83rd
- 5 Judicial District.
- 6 SECTION 3. (a) The local administrative district judge
- 7 shall transfer all cases from Upton County that are pending in the
- 8 83rd District Court on September 1, 2003, to the 112th District
- 9 Court.
- 10 (b) When a case is transferred as provided by Subsection (a)
- 11 of this section, all processes, writs, bonds, recognizances, or
- 12 other obligations issued from the 83rd District Court are
- 13 returnable to the 112th District Court as if originally issued by
- 14 that court. The obligees on all bonds and recognizances taken in
- and for the 83rd District Court and all witnesses summoned to appear
- in the 83rd District Court are required to appear before the 112th
- 17 District Court as if originally required to appear before that
- 18 court.
- 19 SECTION 4. Section 43.141(a), Government Code, as amended
- 20 by this Act, does not affect the election of a district attorney for
- 21 the 83rd Judicial District held before September 1, 2003. The
- 22 district attorney of the 83rd Judicial District elected before and
- 23 serving on that date shall serve the remainder of the elected term,
- 24 unless otherwise removed by law.
- 25 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
