A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT 1 2 relating to the creation of employee wellness programs by state 3 agencies. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Chapter 664, Government Code, is amended by 5 6 adding Section 664.007 to read as follows: Sec. 664.007. EMPLOYEE WELLNESS PROGRAM. (a) Each state 7 agency shall designate an individual as the wellness coordinator 8 for the agency. The wellness coordinator may collaborate with 9 other agencies and sources to provide information and resources to 10 employees through bulletin boards and e-mail. The employee 11 12 wellness program may include: 13 (1) an agency wellness center staffed by a nurse 14 practitioner who provides employees with services such as blood pressure monitoring and annual health assessments; 15 16 (2) ergonomic office equipment; (3) nutrition education; 17 (4) smoking cessation programs; and 18 (5) contracts with fitness centers for reduced 19 membership fees for state employees with a portion of the fees paid 20 21 by the state. 22 (b) A state agency with fewer than 100 employees may join 23 with a state agency with 100 employees or more to create a program 24 under this section and to share resources under the program.
