A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the establishment of security forces in certain 3 metropolitan rapid transit authorities. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 451.108, Transportation Code, is amended 5 6 by amending Subsections (a) and (b) and by adding Subsection (d) to read as follows: 7 An authority may establish a security force, employ 8 (a) 9 security personnel, and commission security personnel as [and employ] peace officers. 10 A peace officer commissioned under this section, except 11 (b) 12 as provided by <u>Subsections (c) and (d)</u> [Subsection (c)], may: 13 (1) make an arrest in any county in which the transit 14 authority system is located as necessary to prevent or abate the commission of an offense against the law of this state or a 15 political subdivision of this state if the offense or threatened 16 offense occurs on or involves the transit authority system or its 17 18 users; (2) make an arrest for an offense involving injury or 19 detriment to the transit authority system or its users; 20 21 (3) enforce [traffic] laws and investigate traffic 22 accidents that involve or occur in the transit authority system; 23 and (4) provide emergency and public safety services to 24

1 the transit authority system or users of the transit authority 2 system.

3 (d) A peace officer who holds a commission under this 4 section from an authority created before 1980 in which the principal municipality has a population of less than 1.2 million 5 6 and who has filed with the authority the oath of a peace officer has 7 all the powers, privileges, and immunities of peace officers in the counties in which the transit authority system is located, provides 8 services, or is supported by a general sales and use tax while the 9 peace officer is on the transit authority system property or 10 performing duties in connection with the transit authority system 11 12 or its users. 13 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
