A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to a memorandum of understanding between the Texas School 3 for the Blind and Visually Impaired and the Texas Education Agency. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 30.005, Education Code, is amended to 5 6 read as follows: Sec. 30.005. TEXAS SCHOOL FOR THE BLIND AND VISUALLY 7 IMPAIRED MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING. The Texas Education Agency 8 and the Texas School for the Blind and Visually Impaired shall 9 develop, agree to, and by commissioner rule adopt [no later than 10 September 1, 1998,] a memorandum of understanding to establish: 11 12 (1) the method for developing and reevaluating a set 13 of indicators of the quality of learning at the Texas School for the Blind and Visually Impaired; 14 (2) the process for the agency to conduct and report on 15 an annual evaluation of the school's performance on the indicators; 16 (3) the requirements for the school's board to 17 18 publish, discuss, and disseminate an annual report describing the educational performance of the school; [and] 19 (4) the type of information the school shall be 20 21 required to provide through the Public Education Information 22 Management System (PEIMS); and 23 (5) the process for the agency to assign an accreditation status to the school, to reevaluate the status on an 24

## 1 annual basis, and, if necessary, to make on-site accreditation 2 investigations.

3 SECTION 2. Not later than September 1, 2004, the Texas 4 Education Agency and the Texas School for the Blind and Visually 5 Impaired shall develop, agree to, and by commissioner of education 6 rule adopt a memorandum of understanding concerning issues 7 specified by Section 30.005(5), Education Code, as added by this 8 Act.

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
