## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the period for which a court may order temporary

3 inpatient mental health services for certain persons.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 574.034(g), Health and Safety Code, is

6 amended to read as follows:

- 7 (g) An order for temporary inpatient or outpatient mental
- 8 health services shall state that treatment is authorized for not
- 9 longer than 90 days. The order may not specify a shorter period <u>for</u>
- 10 <u>a proposed patient whom the trier of fact finds is likely to cause</u>
- 11 <u>serious harm to himself or others.</u> As an alternative to an order
- 12 authorizing treatment for 90 days, for a proposed patient whom the
- 13 trier of fact finds to be mentally ill and to meet the criteria
- 14 provided by Subsection (a)(2)(C), the judge may issue an order for
- 15 inpatient temporary mental health services for stabilization
- 16 purposes for a period not to exceed 30 days.
- 17 SECTION 2. (a) This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
- 18 (b) The change in law made by this Act applies to a
- 19 proceeding regarding an application for court-ordered temporary
- 20 mental health services under Section 574.034, Health and Safety
- 21 Code, as amended by this Act, regardless of the time the application
- 22 was made.
