2 SECTION 3. APPLICABILITY. (a) Section 2 of this Act does 3 not apply to:

4 (1) an act, proceeding, commissioner, other official,
5 bond, or other obligation the validity of which or of whom is the
6 subject of litigation that is pending on the effective date of this
7 Act;

8 (2) an act or proceeding relating to the conveyance by 9 a district of any interest in real property that had originally been 10 patented or otherwise conveyed to the district by the state if the 11 act or proceeding by the district violated a restriction or 12 condition of the patent or other conveyance from the state; or

13 (3) an act or proceeding that violated Section 61.117,14 Water Code.

(b) This Act does not validate any governmental act or proceeding that, under the law of this state at the time the act or proceeding occurred, was a misdemeanor or a felony.

18 SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect September19 1, 2003.
