- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 164.004, Health and Safety Code, is 7 amended to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 164.004. EXEMPTIONS. This chapter does not apply to:
- 9 (1) a treatment facility:
- 10 (A) operated by the Texas Department of Mental
- 11 Health and Mental Retardation, a federal agency, or a political
- 12 subdivision; or
- 13 (B) funded by the Texas Commission on Alcohol and
- 14 Drug Abuse;

- 15 (2) a community center established under Subchapter A,
- 16 Chapter 534, or a facility operated by a community center; or
- 17 (3) a facility owned and operated by a nonprofit or
- 18 not-for-profit organization offering counseling concerning family
- 19 violence, help for runaway children, or rape.
- 20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
