1-6 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to the application of certain marketing and contracting  
1-9 restrictions to treatment facilities funded by the Texas Commission  
1-10 on Alcohol and Drug Abuse.

1-11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-12 SECTION 1. Section 164.004, Health and Safety Code, is  
1-13 amended to read as follows:

1-14 Sec. 164.004. EXEMPTIONS. This chapter does not apply to:

1-15 (1) a treatment facility:

1-16 (A) operated by the Texas Department of Mental  
1-17 Health and Mental Retardation, a federal agency, or a political  
1-18 subdivision; or

1-19 (B) funded by the Texas Commission on Alcohol and  
1-20 Drug Abuse;

1-21 (2) a community center established under Subchapter A,  
1-22 Chapter 534, or a facility operated by a community center; or

1-23 (3) a facility owned and operated by a nonprofit or  
1-24 not-for-profit organization offering counseling concerning family  
1-25 violence, help for runaway children, or rape.

1-26 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
1-27 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
1-28 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
1-29 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
1-30 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.

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
