- 2 relating to awards granted under the Texas Advanced Placement
- 3 Incentive Program.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 28.053, Education Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 28.053. TYPES OF AWARDS. (a) A school participating
- 8 in the program may be awarded:
- 9 (1) a one-time \$3,000 equipment grant for providing a
- 10 college advanced placement course or international baccalaureate
- 11 course to be paid to a school based on need as determined by the
- 12 commissioner; and
- 13 (2) \$100 for each student who scores a three or better
- 14 on a college advanced placement test or four or better on an
- international baccalaureate examination.
- 16 (b) Funds awarded under Subsection (a) shall be used in the
- 17 manner determined by the campus team established, by the principal,
- 18 under Subsection (c).
- (c) The principal of each school participating in the
- 20 program shall convene, at least annually, a team composed of not
- 21 more than five members, with not fewer than three teachers, to
- 22 include at least one teacher participating in the program and at
- 23 least one teacher who teaches students in preparation for their
- 24 participation in the program, for the purpose of determining the

- 1 use of funds awarded under Subsection (a). Nothing in this section
- 2 limits the authority of the team to direct expenditure of funds
- 3 awarded under Subsection (a)(2) for awards to individual teachers
- 4 participating in the program.
- 5 (d) A teacher participating in the program may be awarded:
- 6 (1) subsidized teacher training, not to exceed \$450
- 7 for each teacher, for a college advanced placement course or <u>an</u>
- 8 international baccalaureate course;
- 9 (2) a one-time award of \$250 for teaching a college
- 10 advanced placement course or an international baccalaureate course
- 11 for the first time; and
- 12 (3) a share of the teacher bonus pool, which shall be
- 13 distributed by the teacher's school in shares proportional to the
- 14 number of courses taught.
- (e) [(c)] To be eligible for an award under Subsection (d)
- 16 [(b)], a teacher must teach a college advanced placement course or
- 17 an international baccalaureate course.
- (f) $[\frac{d}{d}]$ Fifty dollars may be deposited in the teacher
- 19 bonus pool for each student enrolled in the school that scores a
- 20 three or better on a college advanced placement test or four or
- 21 better on an international baccalaureate examination.
- 22 $\underline{(g)}$ [$\underline{(e)}$] A student receiving a score of three or better on
- 23 a college advanced placement test or four or better on an
- international baccalaureate examination may receive reimbursement,
- 25 not to exceed \$65, for the testing fee. The reimbursement shall be
- reduced by the amount of any subsidy awarded by the college board or
- 27 the International Baccalaureate Organization or under Section

- 1 28.054.
- 2 (h) [(f)] The commissioner may enter into agreements with
- 3 the college board and the International Baccalaureate Organization
- 4 to pay for all examinations taken by eligible public school
- 5 students. An eligible student is one who takes a college advanced
- 6 placement or international baccalaureate course at a public school
- 7 or who is recommended by the student's principal or teacher to take
- 8 the test.
- 9 $\underline{\text{(i)}}$ [$\frac{\text{(g)}}{\text{)}}$] The commissioner shall analyze and adjust, as
- 10 needed, the sum of and number of awards to ensure that the purpose
- 11 of the program is realized.
- 12 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 13 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 14 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 15 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 16 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
