## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT 2 relating to information that must be included in the adjutant 3 general's annual report. Δ BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 SECTION 1. Section 431.034, Government Code, is amended to 6 read as follows: Sec. 431.034. REPORT. The adjutant general annually shall 7 report to the governor. The report shall be delivered to the 8 legislature. The report must include: 9 and detailed written 10 (1) a complete statement accounting for all funds received and disbursed by the department 11 12 during the preceding fiscal year that meets the reporting 13 requirements applicable to financial reporting provided in the General Appropriations Act; 14 15 (2) an account, to the extent of the adjutant general's knowledge, of all arms, ammunition, and other military property 16 owned by or in possession of the state, the source from which it was 17 received, to whom it is issued, and its present condition; 18 19 (3) a statement of the number, condition, and organization of the Texas National Guard and reserve militia; [and] 20 suggestions that the adjutant general considers 21 (4) 22 important to the military interests and conditions of the state and 23 the perfection of its military organization; (5) a list and description of all Texas National Guard 24
