1-6 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to information that must be included in the adjutant
1-9 general's annual report.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Section 431.034, Government Code, is amended to
1-12 read as follows:

1-13 Sec. 431.034. REPORT. The adjutant general annually shall
1-14 report to the governor. The report shall be delivered to the
1-15 legislature. The report must include:

1-16 (1) a complete and detailed written statement
1-17 accounting for all funds received and disbursed by the department
1-18 during the preceding fiscal year that meets the reporting
1-19 requirements applicable to financial reporting provided in the
1-20 General Appropriations Act;

1-21 (2) an account, to the extent of the adjutant general's
1-22 knowledge, of all arms, ammunition, and other military property
1-23 owned by or in possession of the state, the source from which it was
1-24 received, to whom it is issued, and its present condition;

1-25 (3) a statement of the number, condition, and
1-26 organization of the Texas National Guard and reserve militia; ~~and~~

1-27 (4) suggestions that the adjutant general considers
1-28 important to the military interests and conditions of the state and
1-29 the perfection of its military organization;

1-30 (5) a list and description of all Texas National Guard
1-31 missions that are in progress at the time the report is prepared;
1-32 and

1-33 (6) a statement of department plans to obtain and
1-34 maintain future Texas National Guard missions, including proposed
1-35 missions that are consistent with the United States Department of
1-36 Defense's war-fighting strategies, including strategies used in
1-37 the war on terrorism.

1-38 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.

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
