4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 25.005 (a), Education Code, is amended 6 to read as follows:

(a) It is the intent of the Legislature that children of the men and women who valiantly serve our nation in the military may transfer into Texas public schools with minimum disruption to their educational advancement. [To facilitate the transfer of military personnel and their dependents to and from the public schools of this state] and to ensure those students are not penalized as a result of mandatory relocation, the agency shall identify states having a significant number of students transferring to Texas

15 public schools and, within available resources, enter into [may

pursue] reciprocity agreements with other states governing the

terms of those transfers.

Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
