- 4 SECTION 1. Article 2301.476, Occupations Code, is amended 5 by adding Subsection (h) to read as follows:

- 11 (1) Motor vehicles that have been used exclusively and
- 12 regularly by the person or entity in the conduct of its rental
- 13 business; and
- 14 (2) Used motor vehicles traded in on motor vehicles

- 16 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 19 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 20 Act takes effect June 1, 2003.
- 21 SECTION 3. The importance of this legislation and the
- 22 crowded condition of the calendars in both houses create an
- 23 emergency and an imperative public necessity that the
- 24 constitutional rule requiring bills to be read on three several
