A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

relating to composition of the board of the Texas School for the 1-8 1-9 Deaf. 1-10 1-11

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Subsection (a), Section 30.052, Education Code, is amended to read as follows:

for the Deaf is governed 1-13 (a) The Texas School by a nine-member board appointed by the governor in accordance with this 1-14 1**-**15 1**-**16 section and confirmed by the senate. A person may not serve simultaneously on the school's governing board and the board of the Texas Commission for the Deaf and Hard of Hearing. Subject to the 1-17 other specific membership requirements of this subsection, [Each 1-18 <u>member of</u>] the board <u>may include one or more representatives of the public</u> [must be a person who is experienced in working with persons who are deaf or hard of hearing, a person who is the parent of a person who is deaf, or a person who is deaf]. The board, at least five of whom must be deaf <u>or hard of hearing</u>, <u>must include</u> [consists 1-19 1-20 1-21 1-22 1-23 1-24 of]:

1-25 (1)at least one person who is an alumnus of the Texas 1-26 School for the Deaf;

(2) at least three persons who are parents of a [deaf] 1-27 1-28 person who is deaf or hard of hearing; and
