1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to composition of the board of the Texas School for the  
1-9 Deaf.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Subsection (a), Section 30.052, Education Code,  
1-12 is amended to read as follows:

1-13 (a) The Texas School for the Deaf is governed by a  
1-14 nine-member board appointed by the governor in accordance with this  
1-15 section and confirmed by the senate. A person may not serve  
1-16 simultaneously on the school's governing board and the board of the  
1-17 Texas Commission for the Deaf and Hard of Hearing. Subject to the  
1-18 other specific membership requirements of this subsection, [Each  
1-19 member of] the board may include one or more representatives of the  
1-20 public [must be a person who is experienced in working with persons  
1-21 who are deaf or hard of hearing, a person who is the parent of a  
1-22 person who is deaf, or a person who is deaf]. The board, at least  
1-23 five of whom must be deaf or hard of hearing, must include [consists  
1-24 of]:

1-25 (1) at least one person who is an alumnus of the Texas  
1-26 School for the Deaf;

1-27 (2) at least three persons who are parents of a [deaf]  
1-28 person who is deaf or hard of hearing; and

1-29 (3) at least three persons who are experienced in  
1-30 working with [deaf] persons who are deaf or hard of hearing.

1-31 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
