Section 47.004, Parks and Wildlife Code, 11 is 12 amended to read as follows: 13 Sec. 47.004. RESIDENT FISHING GUIDE LICENSE. (a) No 14 resident [person] may engage in business as a fishing guide unless the resident [person] has obtained a resident fishing guide 15 license. 16 The license fee for a resident fishing guide license is 17 (b) 18 \$50 or an amount set by the commission, whichever amount is more. (c) The commission may adopt rules governing the issuance 19 and use of a resident fishing guide license, including rules 20 creating separate resident fishing guide licenses for use in 21 saltwater and freshwater. 22 SECTION 3. Subchapter A, Chapter 47, Parks and Wildlife 23 Code, is amended by adding Section 47.005 to read as follows: 24
