## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the operation of public school transportation systems.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Subsection (b), Section 34.007, Education Code,
5	is amended to read as follows:
6	(b) In establishing and operating the transportation
7	system, the county or school district board:
8	(1) shall employ school bus drivers certified in
9	accordance with standards and qualifications adopted by the
10	Department of Public Safety; and
11	(2) may allow a parent to designate <u>one of the</u>
12	following locations [a child-care facility, as defined by Section
13	42.002, Human Resources Code,] instead of the child's residence as
14	the regular location for purposes of obtaining transportation under
15	the system to and from the child's school <u>:</u>
16	(A) a child-care facility, as defined by Section
17	42.002, Human Resources Code; or
18	(B) the residence of a grandparent of the child.
19	SECTION 2. Subsection (k), Section 42.155, Education Code,
20	is amended to read as follows:
21	(k) Notwithstanding any other provision of this section,
22	the commissioner may not reduce the allotment to which a district or
23	county is entitled under this section because the district or
24	county provides transportation for an eligible student to and from

1 a child-care facility, as defined by Section 42.002, Human 2 Resources Code, <u>or a grandparent's residence</u> instead of the 3 student's residence, as authorized by Section 34.007, if the 4 transportation is provided within the approved routes of the 5 district or county for the school the student attends.

6 SECTION 3. This Act applies beginning with the 2003-2004 7 school year.

8 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 9 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 10 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 11 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 12 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
