- 2 relating to the permissible size of certain recreational vehicles

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter Y, Chapter 622, Transportation Code,
- 6 is amended by amending Section 622.901 and adding Section 622.903
- 7 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 622.901. WIDTH EXCEPTIONS. The width limitation
- 9 provided by Section 621.201 does not apply to:
- 10 (1) highway building or maintenance machinery that is
- 11 traveling:
- 12 (A) during daylight on a public highway other
- than a highway that is part of the national system of interstate and
- 14 defense highways; or
- 15 (B) for not more than 50 miles on a highway that
- is part of the national system of interstate and defense highways;
- 17 (2) a vehicle traveling during daylight on a public
- 18 highway other than a highway that is part of the national system of
- 19 interstate and defense highways or traveling for not more than 50
- 20 miles on a highway that is part of the national system of interstate
- 21 and defense highways if the vehicle is:
- 22 (A) a farm tractor or implement of husbandry; or
- 23 (B) a vehicle on which a farm tractor or
- 24 implement of husbandry, other than a tractor or implement being

- 1 transported from one dealer to another, is being moved by the owner
- of the tractor or implement or by an agent or employee of the owner:
- 3 (i) to deliver the tractor or implement to a
- 4 new owner;
- 5 (ii) to transport the tractor or implement
- 6 to or from a mechanic for maintenance or repair; or
- 7 (iii) in the course of an agricultural
- 8 operation;
- 9 (3) machinery that is used solely for drilling water
- 10 wells, including machinery that is a unit or a unit mounted on a
- 11 conventional vehicle or chassis, and that is traveling:
- 12 (A) during daylight on a public highway other
- 13 than a highway that is part of the national system of interstate and
- 14 defense highways; or
- 15 (B) for not more than 50 miles on a highway that
- is part of the national system of interstate and defense highways;
- 17 (4) a vehicle owned or operated by a public, private,
- or volunteer fire department; [or]
- 19 (5) a vehicle registered under Section 502.164; or
- 20 (6) a recreational vehicle to which Section 622.903
- 21 applies.
- Sec. 622.903. WIDTH LIMITATION ON CERTAIN RECREATIONAL
- 23 <u>VEHICLES. (a) In this section:</u>
- (1) "Appurtenance" includes an awning, a grab handle,
- 25 <u>lighting equipment</u>, or a vent. The term does not include a
- load-carrying device.
- 27 (2) "Recreational vehicle" has the meaning assigned by

- 1 <u>Section 522.004.</u>
- 2 (b) A recreational vehicle may exceed a width limitation
- 3 established by Section 621.201 or 621.202 if the excess width is
- 4 attributable to an appurtenance that extends six inches or less
- 5 beyond a fender on one or both sides of the vehicle.
- 6 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
