S.B. No. 651

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the effective date of a driver's license suspension for
3 failure to pass a test for intoxication.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 524.021(a), Transportation Code, is
6 amended to read as follows:

7 (a) A driver's license suspension under this chapter takes
8 effect on the 30th [~~40th~~] day after the date the person:

9 (1) receives a notice of suspension under Section
10 524.011; or

11 (2) is presumed to have received notice of suspension
12 under Section 524.013.

13 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003. The
14 change in law made by this Act applies only to an offense committed
15 on or after the effective date of this Act. An offense committed
16 before the effective date of this Act is covered by the law in
17 effect when the offense was committed, and the former law is
18 continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of this section,
19 an offense was committed before the effective date of this Act if
20 any element of the offense occurred before that date.
