3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 434, Government Code, is
5	amended by adding Sections 434.0072, 434.0073, 434.0074, and
6	434.0075 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 434.0072. WEBSITE. (a) The Department of Information
8	Resources shall establish an Internet site using "TexasOnline" to
9	allow veterans to access information on state and federal veterans
10	benefits programs.
11	(b) The website must allow a veteran to electronically file
12	for state veterans benefits, including the electronic signing of
13	the filing by the veteran and an electronic acknowledgment of the
14	filing by the Texas Veterans Commission.
15	(c) The website may allow a veteran to electronically file
16	for selected federal veterans benefits as specified by the Texas
17	Veterans Commission upon reprints.

- Sec. 434.0073. COMMISSION FORMS. Commission forms shall 18
- contain the Internet website address of TexasOnline benefits 19
- 20 information and toll-free telephone number.
- Sec. 434.0074. BENEFITS BOOKLETS. (a) Not later than 21
- February 1 of each even-numbered year, the commission shall create 22
- an electronic version of a state veterans benefits booklet and 23
- 24 provide a hard copy and electronic version of the booklet to:

- 3 military installation in this state.
- The commission shall place an electronic version of the booklet on its website.
- 6 (b) A veterans county service officer is encouraged to
 7 distribute a copy of the booklet to any person who claims or will
 8 claim Texas as a residence after discharge from the United States
 9 armed forces. The veterans county service officer shall make a copy
 10 of the booklet available at the county veterans' service office.
- 11 (c) The commission may update the booklet as necessary.
- 12 Sec. 434.0075. ELECTRONIC ACCESS TO NEWSLETTER OR SERVICES.
- 13 The commission, within available resources and with the assistance
- 14 of the executive director of the Department of Information
- 15 Resources, shall develop and implement a program that uses
- 16 appropriate computer hardware and software and required training
- 17 programs to facilitate electronic:
- 18 (1) delivery of a veterans newsletter; and
- 19 (2) initiation of veterans benefits claims by veterans
- 20 <u>county service officers.</u>

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The Commission, within available resources, shall work with the Windham Intermediate School District to establish a process whereby refurbished computers in a quantity jointly determined by the Commission and District shall be provided at no cost to interested county service officers. County service officers that obtain computers through this process shall make computers available to veterans served by their respective counties either on

- 1 site or through a lending process in a manner determined by the
- 2 county service officers and approved by the county commissioners
- 3 court.
- 4 SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 434, Government Code, is
- 5 amended by adding Section 434.039 to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 434.039. OFFICER PERFORMANCE. The commission shall
- 7 provide on their website information that may be voluntarily used
- 8 by counties to link evaluations of officer performance with the
- 9 percentage of veterans benefits claims successfully filed by an
- 10 officer.
- 11 SECTION 3. Subchapter B, Chapter 656, Government Code, is
- 12 amended by adding Section 656.027 to read as follows:
- Sec. 656.027. PREFERENCE FOR VETERANS ON STATE EMPLOYMENT
- 14 FORMS. As new forms are published, and within available resources,
- 15 the commission shall include on all forms relating to state agency
- 16 employment that are prescribed by the commission under this
- 17 <u>subchapter</u> or other law a statement regarding the requirement
- 18 prescribed by Chapter 657 that each state agency have as its goal an
- 19 agency workforce composed of at least 40 percent veterans.
- 20 SECTION 4. Subchapter C, Chapter 161, Natural Resources
- 21 Code, is amended by adding Section 161.075 to read as follows:
- Sec. 161.075. INFORMATION FOR LENDING INSTITUTIONS.
- 23 (a) In this section, "lending institution" has the meaning
- 24 <u>assigned by Section 161.502.</u>
- 25 (b) On request, the board shall provide to a lending
- 26 institution information regarding state land and housing benefits
- 27 programs for veterans in this state.

- 1 SECTION 5. Chapter 105, Election Code, is amended by adding
- 2 Section 105.003 to read as follows:
- 3 Sec. 105.003. ELECTRONIC VOTING. (a) Within existing
- 4 appropriations, the secretary of state shall explore the
- 5 feasibility of establishing a process whereby a person may cast an
- 6 electronic ballot if the person is:
- 7 (1) a member of the armed forces of the United States
- 8 who is on active duty overseas; or
- 9 (2) a spouse or dependent of a person described by
- 10 Subdivision (1) who will be outside the United States on election
- 11 day and during the early voting period for the election.
- 12 (b) The secretary of state shall recommend possible means by
- 13 which:
- 14 (1) upon the request of a person described in (1) and
- 15 (2) of Sec. 105.003, an electronic ballot may be sent to and
- 16 <u>received from the voter;</u>
- 17 (2) the identity of the voter may be verified;
- 18 (3) the security of the electronic transmission may be
- 19 ensured; and
- 20 (4) any other requirements the secretary of state
- 21 determines are necessary may be met.
- SECTION 6. Not later than September 1, 2004, the Texas
- 23 Veterans Commission and the executive director of the Department of
- 24 Information Resources shall develop and implement the initial
- 25 program required by Section 434.0075, Government Code, as added by
- 26 this Act.
- SECTION 7. Not later than December 1, 2005, the secretary of

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- 1 state shall submit recommendations to the Legislature regarding an
- 2 electronic system as required by Section 105.003, Election Code, as
- 3 added by this Act.
- 4 SECTION 8. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
