## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to an additional cost on conviction of an offense for 3 roadway safety and traffic enforcement. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Article 102.075, Code of Criminal Procedure, is 5 6 amended by adding Subsection (p) to read as follows: (p) In addition to other costs on conviction imposed under 7 this article, a person shall pay \$5 on conviction of any felony or 8 misdemeanor. The comptro<u>ller shall deposit 10 percent of the money</u> 9 received under this subsection to the credit of the Center for 10 Transportation Safety under Subchapter J, Chapter 88, Education 11 12 Code, and the remainder to the credit of the Department of Public Safety account in the general revenue fund to be used at the 13 14 discretion of the public safety director to provide additional traffic enforcement in areas for which the department determines a 15 need. Subsection (h) does not apply to money received under this 16 subsection. 17 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect January 1, 2004. 18 SECTION 3. (a) Article 102.075(p), Code of Criminal 19 Procedure, as added by this Act, applies only to an offense 20 21 committed on or after the effective date of this Act. For purposes 22 of this section, an offense is committed before the effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurs before the 23 effective date. 24
