1-8 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-9 AN ACT

1-10 relating to an additional cost on conviction of an offense for
1-11 roadway safety and traffic enforcement.

1-12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-13 SECTION 1. Article 102.075, Code of Criminal Procedure, is
1-14 amended by adding Subsection (p) to read as follows:

1-15 (p) In addition to other costs on conviction imposed under
1-16 this article, a person shall pay a \$2.50 penalty on conviction of
1-17 any felony or misdemeanor. The comptroller shall deposit 20
1-18 percent of the money received under this subsection to the credit of
1-19 the Center for Transportation Safety under Subchapter J, Chapter
1-20 88, Education Code, and the remainder to the credit of the
1-21 Department of Public Safety account in the general revenue fund to
1-22 be used at the discretion of the public safety director to provide
1-23 additional traffic enforcement in areas for which the department
1-24 determines a need. Subsection (h) does not apply to money received
1-25 under this subsection.

1-26 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect January 1, 2004.

1-27 SECTION 3. (a) Subsection (p), Article 102.075, Code of
1-28 Criminal Procedure, as added by this Act, applies only to an offense
1-29 committed on or after the effective date of this Act. For purposes
1-30 of this section, an offense is committed before the effective date
1-31 of this Act if any element of the offense occurs before the
1-32 effective date.

1-33 (b) An offense committed before the effective date of this
1-34 Act is covered by the law in effect when the offense was committed,
1-35 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
