1-8 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-9 AN ACT

1-10 relating to the boards of trustees of certain school districts.
1-11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
1-12 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 11, Education Code, is
1-13 amended by adding Section 11.064 to read as follows:
1-14 Sec. 11.064. APPLICABILITY TO CERTAIN DISTRICTS.
1-15 (a) Sections 11.052(g) and (h) and Sections 11.059(a) and (b) do
1-16 not apply to the board of trustees of a school district if:
1-17 (1) the district's central administrative office is
1-18 located in a county with a population of more than two million; and
1-19 (2) the district's student enrollment is more than
1-20 125,000 and less than 200,000.
1-21 (b) Section 11.053 of this code and Section 141.001,
1-22 Election Code, apply to the board of trustees of a school district
1-23 described by Subsection (a).
1-24 (c) A trustee of a school district described by Subsection
1-25 (a) may not serve a term that exceeds four years.
1-26 (d) Notwithstanding Chapter 171, Acts of the 50th
1-27 Legislature, Regular Session, 1947 (Article 2783d, Vernon's Texas
1-28 Civil Statutes), to the extent consistent with this section, the
1-29 board of trustees of a school district described by Subsection (a)
1-30 may adopt rules necessary to govern the term, election, and
1-31 residency requirements of members of the board.
1-32 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-33 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-34 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-35 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-36 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
