## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 531, Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Sections 531.02173 and 531.02174 to read as
7	follows:
8	Sec. 531.02173. ALIGNMENT OF MEDICAID TELEMEDICINE
9	REIMBURSEMENT POLICIES WITH MEDICARE REIMBURSEMENT POLICIES.
10	(a) The commission shall periodically review policies regarding
11	reimbursement under the Medicaid program for telemedicine medical
12	services to identify variations between permissible reimbursement
13	under that program and reimbursement available to providers under
14	the Medicare program.
15	(b) To the extent practicable, and notwithstanding any
16	other state law, after conducting a review under Subsection (a) the
17	commission may modify rules and procedures applicable to
18	reimbursement under the Medicaid program for telemedicine medical
19	services as necessary to provide for a reimbursement system that is
20	comparable to the reimbursement system for those services under the
21	Medicare program.
22	(c) The commission shall perform its duties under this
23	section with assistance from the telemedicine advisory committee
24	established under Section 531.02172.

2	TELEMEDICINE MEDICAL SERVICES.	(a) In addition	to the authority
3	granted by other law regarding t	celemedicine medic	al services, the
4	commission may review rules	and procedures	applicable to
5	reimbursement of telemedicine r	nedical services	provided through
6	any government-funded health pr	ogram subject to	the commission's
7	oversight.		

8 (b) The commission may modify rules and procedures 9 described by Subsection (a) as necessary to ensure that 10 reimbursement for telemedicine medical services is provided in a 11 cost-effective manner and only in circumstances in which the 12 provision of those services is clinically effective.

13 (c) This section does not affect the commission's authority 14 or duties under other law regarding reimbursement of telemedicine 15 medical services under the Medicaid program.

SECTION 2. If before implementing any provision of this Act a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision, the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the waiver or authorization is granted.

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SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.

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
