- 4 SECTION 1. Section 15.01, Penal Code, is amended by
- 5 amending Subsection (d) and adding Subsection (e) to read as
- 6 follows:
- 7 (d) Except as provided by Subsection (e), an [An] offense
- 8 under this section is one category lower than the offense
- 9 attempted, and if the offense attempted is a state jail felony, the
- 10 offense is a Class A misdemeanor.
- 11 (e) If the offense attempted is murder under Section 19.02,
- 12 the offense is punishable by imprisonment in the institutional
- division for any term of not more than 30 years or less than 2 years.
- 14 In addition to imprisonment, an individual adjudged guilty of
- attempted murder may be punished by a fine not to exceed \$10,000.
- SECTION 2. (a) The change in law made by this Act applies
- only to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this
- 18 Act. For purposes of this section, an offense is committed before
- 19 the effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurs
- 20 before the effective date.
- (b) An offense committed before the effective date of this
- 22 Act is covered by the law in effect when the offense was committed,
- 23 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
