- 2 relating to the ability of certain counties to use lease-purchase
- 3 or licensing agreements.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 263.053, Local Government Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 263.053. SALE AND SUBSEQUENT LEASE OR LICENSE OF
- 8 PROPERTY IN COUNTIES WITH POPULATION OF MORE THAN 250,000
- 9 [500,000]. (a) This section applies only to counties with a
- 10 population of more than 250,000 [500,000].
- 11 (b) The commissioners court of the county may enter into any
- 12 for-profit or other licensing agreement with a seller of wireless
- 13 <u>communications service that may include a license to collocate</u>
- 14 wireless communications technology on property owned by the county.
- 15 (c) The commissioners court of the county may sell land,
- 16 buildings, facilities, or equipment for the purpose of making
- 17 contracts for the lease or rental of land, buildings, facilities,
- 18 or equipment or for receiving services from others for county
- 19 purposes. The commissioners court may pay regular monthly bills
- 20 for utilities, such as electricity, gas, and water, for the
- 21 property leased or rented or for the services received.
- (d)  $[\frac{(c)}{(c)}]$  If a majority of the commissioners court
- 23 determines that the facilities and equipment are essential for the
- 24 proper administration of county government, the commissioners

- 1 court may pay for the facilities and equipment and for the regular
- 2 monthly bills from the general fund of the county. The
- 3 commissioners court must make the payment by warrant in the manner
- 4 that payments for other obligations of the county are made.
- 5 (e) [<del>(d)</del>] A construction project initiated for a purpose
- 6 authorized by this section may be awarded only by a contract that
- 7 provides for the payment of the prevailing wage for all mechanics,
- 8 laborers, and others employed in the construction project. The
- 9 commissioners court of Tarrant County shall set the prevailing
- 10 wage, which must be the same prevailing wage set by the
- 11 commissioners court of that county for all construction projects
- involving the expenditure of county funds.
- (f)  $[\frac{(e)}{(e)}]$  On or before the expiration of a contract made
- 14 under this section, the facilities may be purchased by the county
- 15 and paid for from its general fund if a majority of the
- 16 commissioners court agrees that the purchase price is reasonable.
- 17 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 21 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
