- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subsection (a), Section 284.002, Transportation
- 7 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 8 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b), this chapter
- 9 applies only to a county that:
- 10 (1) has a population of 50,000 or more and borders the
- 11 Gulf of Mexico or a bay or inlet opening into the gulf;
- 12 (2) has a population of 1.5 million or more; [or]
- 13 (3) is adjacent to a county that has a population of
- 14 1.5 million or more; or
- 15 (4) borders the United Mexican States.
- SECTION 2. Section 284.003, Transportation Code, is amended
- 17 to read as follows:
- 18 Sec. 284.003. PROJECT AUTHORIZED; CONSTRUCTION, OPERATION,
- 19 AND COST. A county, acting through the commissioners court of the
- 20 county, or a local government corporation, without state approval,
- 21 supervision, or regulation, may:
- 22 (1) construct, acquire, improve, operate, maintain,
- 23 or pool a project located:
- 24 (A) exclusively in the county;

- 1 (B) [er] in the county and outside the county; or
- 2 (C) in one or more counties adjacent to the
- 3 county;
- 4 (2) issue tax bonds, revenue bonds, or combination tax
- 5 and revenue bonds to pay the cost of the construction, acquisition,
- 6 or improvement of a project; or
- 7 (3) impose tolls or charges as otherwise authorized by
- 8 this chapter.
- 9 SECTION 3. Subsection (d), Section 284.067, Transportation
- 10 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 11 (d) Payment of the purchase price, award, or other cost of
- 12 the project may be on the terms to which the commissioners courts of
- 13 the county issuing the bonds and the other county or counties agree.
- 14 Proceeds from bonds issued under this chapter may be used to pay a
- 15 cost incurred under this section.
- 16 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 19 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 20 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
