- 8 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b), this chapter
- 9 applies only to a county that:
- 10 (1) has a population of 50,000 or more and borders the
- 11 Gulf of Mexico or a bay or inlet opening into the gulf;
- 12 (2) has a population of 1.5 million or more; [<del>or</del>]
- 13 (3) is adjacent to a county that has a population of
- 14 1.5 million or more; or
- 15 (4) borders the United Mexican States.
- SECTION 2. Section 284.003, Transportation Code, is amended
- 17 to read as follows:
- 18 Sec. 284.003. PROJECT AUTHORIZED; CONSTRUCTION, OPERATION,
- 19 AND COST. A county, acting through the commissioners court of the
- 20 county, or a local government corporation, without state approval,
- 21 supervision, or regulation, may:
- 22 (1) construct, acquire, improve, operate, maintain,
- 23 or pool a project located:
- 24 (A) exclusively in the county;

1 <u>(P</u>	B) [ <del>or</del> ]	in the	county	and	outside	the	county <u>;</u>	or
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- 2 (C) in one or more counties adjacent to the
- 3 county;
- 4 (2) issue tax bonds, revenue bonds, or combination tax 5 and revenue bonds to pay the cost of the construction, acquisition,
- 6 or improvement of a project; [or]
- 7 (3) impose tolls or charges as otherwise authorized by 8 this chapter; or
- 9 (4) construct a bridge over a deep water navigation 10 channel if the bridge does not hinder maritime transportation.
- 11 SECTION 3. Section 284.067, Transportation Code, is amended
- 12 by amending Subsection (d) and adding Subsection (e) to read as
- 13 follows:
- (d) Payment of the purchase price, award, or other cost of
- 15 the project may be on the terms to which the commissioners courts of
- 16 the county issuing the bonds and the other county or counties agree.
- 17 Proceeds from bonds issued under this chapter may be used to pay a
- 18 cost incurred under this section.
- 19 <u>(e) Two-tenths of one percent of the toll revenue shall be</u>
- 20 shared equally between the permanent school fund and the General
- 21 Land Office. The General Land Office shall use its share for the
- 22 acquisition of real property in a natural state in the county of the
- 23 project. The acquired land shall be maintained in a natural state.
- 24 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 25 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 26 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 27 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
