5	SECTION 1. Section 6.11, Tax Code, is amended to read as

7	Sec. 6.11. PURCHASING AND CONTRACTING AUTHORITY
8	[COMPETITIVE BIDDING REQUIREMENT]. (a) An [The board of directors
9	of an] appraisal district [may not make a contract requiring an
10	expenditure of more than \$15,000 unless the proposed contract is
11	submitted to competitive bidding.
12	[ <del>(b) The board of directors</del> ] is subject to the same
13	requirements and has the same purchasing and contracting authority
14	[ <del>powers regarding the following matters</del> ] as [ <del>apply to</del> ] a
15	<u>municipality</u> [ <del>commissioners court</del> ] under <u>Chapter 252</u> [ <del>the</del>
16	Certificate of Obligation Act of 1971 (Subchapter C, Chapter 271],
17	Local Government Code <u>.</u>
18	(b) For purposes of this section, all the provisions of
19	Chapter 252, Local Government Code, applicable to a municipality or
20	to purchases and contracts by a municipality apply to an appraisal
21	district and to purchases and contracts by an appraisal district to
22	the extent they can be made applicable, and all references to the
23	municipality in that chapter mean the appraisal district. For
24	purposes of applying Section 252.061, Local Government Code, to an

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1	appraisal district, any resident of the appraisal district may seek
2	an injunction under that section. Sections 252.062 and 252.063,
3	Local Government Code, apply to an officer or employee of an
4	appraisal district in the same manner those sections apply to a
5	municipal officer or employee.[ <del>]:</del>
6	[ <del>(1) notice of the contract;</del>
7	[ <del>(2) issuance of the contract to the lowest</del>
8	responsible bidder;
9	[(3) rejection of bids;
10	[(4) expenditure of funds on the completion and
11	acceptance of the contract;
12	[ <del>(5) exceptions to the competitive bidding</del>
13	requirement;
14	[ <del>(6) change orders; and</del>
15	[ <del>(7) effect of noncompliance with the competitive</del>
16	bidding requirements.
17	[ <del>(c) The notice of the contract shall be published in a</del>
18	newspaper of general circulation in the district. If there is no
19	newspaper of general circulation in the district, the notice shall
20	be posted at the appraisal office for the district.
21	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect July 1, 2003, if it
22	receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each
23	house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution.
24	If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for effect on that
25	date, this Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
