- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- SECTION 1. Section 51.004, Utilities Code, is amended by 5 6 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsections (c) and (d) to read 7 as follows:
- (a) A discount or other form of pricing flexibility may not 8 9 be:
- 10 (1) unreasonably preferential, prejudicial, or discriminatory; or 11
- (2)  $[\tau]$  predatory  $[\tau]$  or anticompetitive. 12
- 13 (c) This title allows an offer based on a reasonable 14 business purpose, including an offer made at any time to a selected 15 customer or a group of customers in response to a competitor's offer or a former customer's acceptance of a competitor's offer if the 16 17 price of the offer meets the requirements of Section 52.0584,
- 58.063, or 59.031. 18

- (d) An offer made under Subsection (c) must be made in 19 compliance with Chapter 43, Business & Commerce Code, as added by 20 Chapter 1429, Acts of the 77th Legislature, Regular Session, 2001. 21
- 22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
